CHARACTERISTICS

Personal Protective Equipment of category III. Made of insulating material. The cups of protectors are made of yellow polystyrene (HIPS), the cup supporting arms and the handles for attaching to the helmet are made of polyacetal (POM) in black, the ear cushions are made of soft PVC. They are height adjustable. The earmuffs are attached to SECRA helmets using the G113.1116 adapters attached to the helmet upon customer's request.

APPLICATION

The earmuffs are used together with the SECRA helmets as a means of hearing protection when carrying out live work.

STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE

The earmuffs should be stored in a clean and dry condition in a way that protects them against mechanical damage. Store in dry and well-ventilated rooms, away from heat sources. Protect against sunlight and intense artificial light.

For cleaning and disinfection, use a mild disinfectant and then wipe with a dry cloth. Do not use solvents and petroleum preparations. Do not immerse the earmuffs in water.

EP-187 Hearing Protectors**EXAMINATION**

Before each use, each earmuff should be visually inspected by the user. Periodic control, which also includes visual inspection, should be carried out once a year. The visual inspection includes checking:

- no visible damage to the cups, the cup supporting arms and the handles
- the condition of the ear cushions

The earmuffs should be withdrawn from use if the cups, cup supporting arms or handles are damaged or if the cushions have become hard or the hearing protection has deteriorated.

CAUTION!

Do not use damaged or dirty protectors in live works.
